


This work is reflected in the indicators of our commitments such as Academic Excellence, Environmental and Social Responsibility, and sustainability and growth.




General information on Student Population



Number of enrolled students in postgraduate programs







Number of admitted students at Postgraduate programs






New Students

Number of enrolled students on first semester in Postgraduate programs





Number of students enrolled in undergraduate programs







Number of graduate students - Postgraduate programs





Geographical Origin of FUCS students at on-site programs




Population of online programs





Geographical Origin of FUCS students at online programs













Number of teachers at FUCS





Distribution of teachers - type of contracts





Distribution of teachers - Working hours





Distribution of teachers' scales

















Internacional Mobility of teachers at FUCS













Evolution of Tutoring and monitoring programs























Placement of students in English Language competence – FUCS


Desertion






Distribution of staff per type of contract







Computers rooms – users






